HOW TO GET THERE

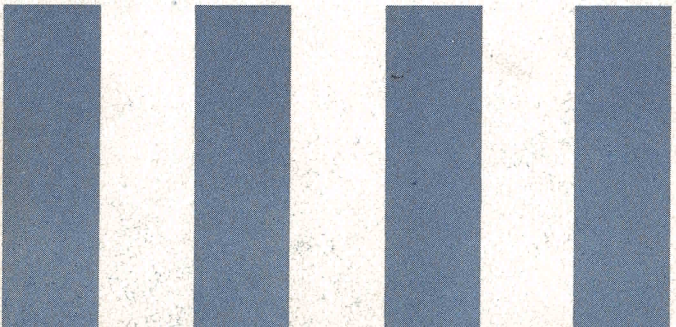
Carousel Mountain is located 4 miles west of Holland and 10 miles north of Saugatuck.

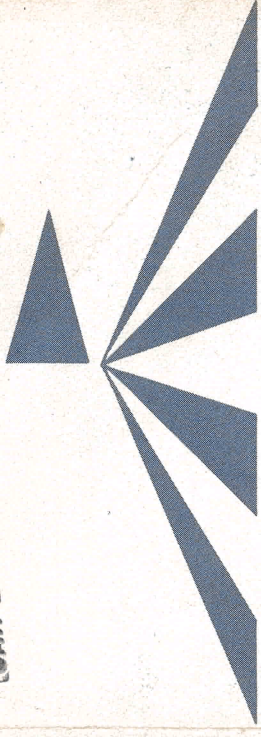

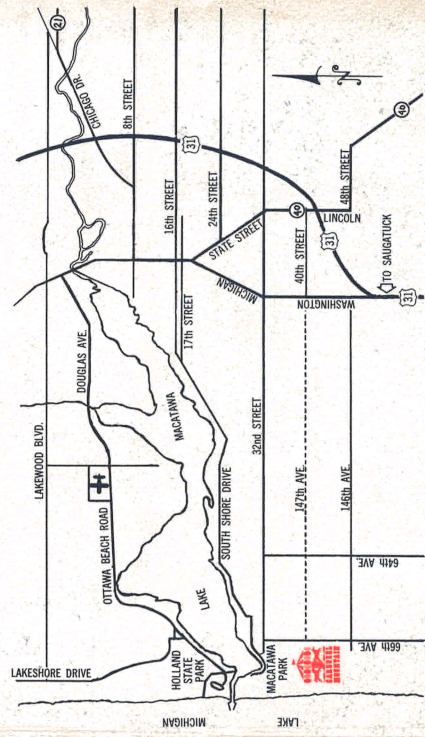

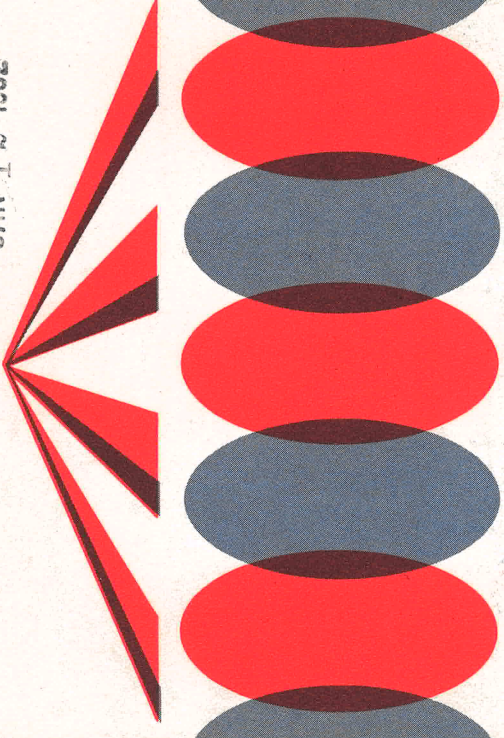
